

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – 25 OCTOBER 2019

We are due to commence maintenance work on the Water Tower, located at the site Entry Garden on Cornwallis Street.

What to expect:

Scaffolding will be erected and during the first couple of days will be used to check the status and review the size / measurements. Then there will be a pause for approximately 1 week then work will resume for another 10 days.

These maintenance works are to ensure the longevity of the tank and include:

- Clearing of plant life and debris from within the tank
- Supply and fixing of a strainer over the drain point
- Supply and fixing of PFC members – for structural stability. Will not be visible.
- Minor removal of lead paint to allow for installation of steel beams
- Preparation and painting of four white poly downpipes
- Fabrication and attachment of bracket on down pipe including fixing loose stays
- Minor touch up of paint
- Clearing soil from base of stand legs

Work duration:

The work will commence next week and take approximately 3 weeks to complete.
