



Aboriginal Cultural Landscape Garden and Native Permaculture Rooftop Garden at ATP

We're excited to be collaborating with Yerrabingin and the community to co-design two interconnected spaces at ATP. These spaces will create a cultural landscape that is a beautiful and an engaging experience.

As part of the co-design process for the Aboriginal Cultural Landscape Garden, Yerrabingin held a workshop for Mirvac staff and members of the Aboriginal community, which included a visit to Mount Annan. The purpose of the visit was to view native plants species in situ, and to inspire participants to brainstorm design features for the garden.

The co-design process also included a drop-in bush tucker lunch at ATP. Workers and visitors to the site had the chance to taste smoked kangaroo and fish combined with other native ingredients such as native spinach, finger limes, rainforest plum, macadamias, saltbush, and lemon and cinnamon myrtle. The intention of the lunch was to demonstrate possible experiences and functions for the space, and to gather feedback about the initial prototype for the Aboriginal Cultural Landscape Garden.

The Native Permaculture Rooftop Garden will be located on the roof of Building 3, and will be a special place that combines the principles of permaculture, Indigenous knowledge and design thinking to prototype an urban native food farm. The project will include over 30 edible native species and is being designed in collaboration with Junglefy.

Both spaces will not only be places for relaxing, but will also be host to events, workshops and demonstrations about wellness and mindfulness, permaculture, Aboriginal astrology, basket weaving and bush food. Yerrabingin will also create educational programs linked in with local primary school curriculums, as well tourism products for visitors.

Construction Activities

Occurring July – August 2018

BUILDING 1

Major Works:

- Services rough-in to all floors.
- Installation of structural steel and roofing to Level 8 plantroom.
- Completion of external façade.
- Commencement of ground floor and lobby glazing.
- Installation of internal passenger lifts.
- Continuation of internal fit out works.
- Removal of third Tower Crane.
- Commencement of external works to Henderson Rd and Central Ave.

Footpath Closures:

- Davy Rd western footpath between the Sports Courts and Central Ave.
- Central Ave southern footpath between Davy Rd and the western roundabout.
- Henderson Rd landscaped area between the western boundary and the Sports Courts.

BUILDING 2

Major Works:

- Continue structural steel erection, suspended concrete slabs and establishment of perimeter edge protection systems.
- Installation of suspended services to carpark floors.

Footpath Closures:

- Central Ave northern footpath between Davy Rd and Mitchell Way.
- Locomotive Street southern footpath between Mitchell Way and Central Plaza.

Road Closures:

- Central Ave north will be closed during construction hours.

BUILDING 3

Major Works:

- Continue structural steel erection, suspended concrete slabs and establishment of perimeter edge protection systems.
- Installation of suspended services to ground floor.
- Installation of pre-cast concrete panels to lift and stair cores.

PUBLIC DOMAIN

Innovation Plaza and Entry Garden:

- Formwork, reinforcement and concrete installation works.
- Regrading and drainage works.
- Installation of new services.
- Installation of the lift to Entry Garden.
- Establishment of landscaping and planter beds.

Central Avenue and Henderson Road

- Formwork, reinforcement and concrete installation works.
- Construction of new kerb and gutter, paving and tree pits along Central Ave.
- Regrading and drainage works.
- Commencement of external works on the Henderson Rd façade of Building 1.
- Commencement of landscaping along Henderson Rd and Central Ave.
- Establishment of landscaping and planter beds.

Footpath Closures:

- Pedestrian diversions will be in place on Central Ave outside the Media City building over the next two months. These diversions will enable the installation of a new kerb and gutter, street lighting, paving and landscaping. The taxi zone, loading zones and pick-up and drop-off areas for the Media City building will remain in place at all times.
- Pedestrians travelling through Innovation Plaza and the Entry Garden are to be diverted down Cornwallis Street footpath – building access will remain open.
- Hoarding/fences will remain installed at Henderson Rd frontage and Vice Chancellor's Oval.
- One half of Vice Chancellor's Oval to remain closed with footpath access to remain open.
