



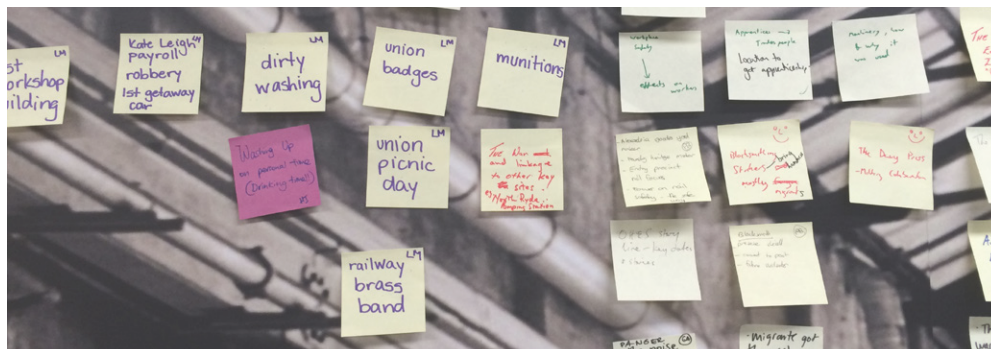

## Construction Milestones

On Monday, 26 February Mirvac held a topping-out celebration for Building 1 at ATP. Building 1 is the first of 3 new buildings at ATP to be built for our anchor tenant CBA. The topping out of Building 1 is an important milestone that marks the progress of work at the precinct and is an opportunity for us to celebrate what has been achieved to date at ATP.

Mirvac's transformation of ATP to a significant destination for work, diverse retail and the community is well underway.

To date on site, we have used:

- 23,200 cubic metres of concrete,
- 2,400 tonnes of steel reinforcement,
- 550 tonnes of structural steel, and
- A total of 480,850 hours of work

The sentiment and tradition of the topping-out celebration was shared with over 100 of Mirvac's key project team and partners as well as film crew from Channel 7 and 9. The ceremony opened with a traditional welcome to country performed by Uncle Ray Davidson and the ceremony was officiated by the Hon. Anthony Roberts MP, Minister for Planning.

Due for completion in April 2019, Building 1 is designed by architects Francis-Jones Morehen Thorp, and will deliver 42,500 square metres of A-grade commercial space designed with connectivity, collaboration and integration in mind.


Building 1 has topped out ahead of schedule and the progress at the site would not have been possible without the unique collaboration and shared vision of all the partners at ATP.

# Construction Activities

*Occurring March - April 2018*

## BUILDING 1

### Major Works:

- Perimeter screen system to be dismantled and removed from site;
- Structure complete and formwork to L8 being removed from site;
- Services rough-in to lower floors;
- Install structural steel to atrium bridge and lift shafts;
- Continue external façade installation;
- Commence plant and atrium roof construction;
- Removal of first Tower Crane.

### Footpath Closures:

- Davy Road Western footpath between the Sports Courts and Central Avenue.
- Central Avenue Southern footpath between Davy Road and the Western roundabout.
- Henderson Road landscaped area between the Western boundary and the Sports Courts.

## BUILDING 2

### Major Works:

- Continue in ground drainage and slab on ground works;
- Continue structural steel erection, suspended concrete works and establishment of perimeter edge protection systems.

### Footpath Closures:

- Central Avenue Northern footpath between Davy Road and Mitchell Way.
- Locomotive Street Southern footpath between Mitchell Way and Central Plaza.

### Road Closures:

- Central Avenue North will be closed during construction hours.

## BUILDING 3

### Major Works:

- Complete incoming and in-ground services works and detailed excavation;
- Commence slab on ground works;
- Commence structural steel erection, suspended concrete works and installation of perimeter edge protection systems.

## PUBLIC DOMAIN

### Innovation Plaza and Entry Garden

- Detailed excavation works and site remediation;
- Installation of services;
- Pavement works;
- Soft scape landscaping;
- Formwork, reinforcement and concrete continue to slab on ground and lift structure works.

### Vice Chancellors Oval

- Installation of services;
- Pavement works;
- Soft scape landscaping.

### Footpath Closures:

- Pedestrians travelling through Innovation Plaza and the Entry Garden are to be diverted down Cornwallis Street footpath – Building access will remain open;
- Hoarding / fences will remain installed at Henderson Road frontage and Vice Chancellors Oval;
- Half of Vice Chancellors Oval to remain closed with footpath access to remain open.
