Specialising in landscape projects and bespoke urban infrastructure, Naturform were engaged to bring the vision for the five hectare space in the heart of Gainsborough Greens to life.

The team has worked tirelessly over the past 12 months to manage and deliver many of the design and construction elements for the project and Naturform Site Supervisor, Matt Soutter, said the result is a one-of-a-kind space for all ages to enjoy.

"Mirvac has such a strong focus on community and Bim'bimba Park is a reflection of that," he said.

"From natural waterways and open spaces to kick a ball, to barbeque areas for families and friends to come together as well as a gigantic playground and an amphitheatre for future events, Bim'bimba Park offers something for everyone.

"The playground caters to all ages and is completely unique, nothing is 'off the shelf."

"As you make your way through, you can see how it incorporates features like spring toys for younger kids through to climbing nets and a fallen tree climbing feature for the older kids, with the jewel of the park being a giant climbing tower."

# WHESAVC DEARTORNWEEDL CRADVIRE

It's been a busy few months at Gainsborough Greens with the delivery of some exciting new recreation facilities for our community to enjoy.

Bim'bimba Park is now open! Complete with bbq facilities, a basketball court, plenty of greenspace, exciting play equipment including the iconic climbing tower, tree climb and amphitheatre. Years in the making, the team were extremely proud to deliver the Bim'bimba Park to the public just in time for Christmas. As the park will be handed over to council, any booking requests will need to be requested through the Gold Coast City Council website per their usual process.

In infrastructure news, we are still awaiting confirmation for the QR bridge opening. As you are aware, Mirvac have completed their required works. We expect the bridge will be operational and open to the public early 2020 and will be in touch as progress develops.

Since its announcement, we have also received some enquiry around the Coomera Connector. The construction of the Coomera Connector would provide an important north-to-south transport link for north Gold Coast communities and ideally ease peak hour congestion within the transport corridor. This is a State Government initiative and outside of Mirvac's control. Further information can be found on the government website: http://statements.qld.gov.au.
