# LOCAL COMMUNITY NEWS

#### Update from Coomera State MP Michael Crandon

The 2018 State Budget saw nothing by way of road funding for the Northern Gold Coast. That means we'll see no resolution at Exit 49, other than (possibly) some remedial work on the northbound Exit which may reduce the dangerous ramping back on to the M1. From a funding perspective, a "diamond in the rough" was the unexpected announcement of funding for a new fire and rescue station to be built in Pimpama. In the whole scheme of things, this was a lower priority than some other infrastructure, but certainly something that is needed to service the fast-growing Pimpama region.

During my budget reply speech, I took the time to outline the traffic issues (among other road issues) at Exit 49. As well, I called for an increase in police numbers, reminding my Parliamentary colleagues that Pimpama is at the epicentre of the fast-growing Northern Gold Coast.

In recent weeks I have again commenced discussion with stakeholders around the need for a Police Citizens Youth Club (PCYC) for the area. A PCYC can offer a wide range of activities to our young people, such as Gymnastics, Martial Arts and Dance, just to name a few. I'm looking forward to progressing this proposal to provide some of the social infrastructure the fastest growing region in Queensland desperately needs.

It's been a busy few months for Mirvac by way of development approvals. Some of which we are still working through with council and some that have reached an approval stage.

We are happy to announce that we have the first round of approvals for the new body corporate rec centre, this will still need to go through the formal building approval process, however we can report that it will have a gym, 25m swimming pool, BBQ's, tennis courts as well as flexible communal shared space. We are looking to start construction on this ASAP, stay tuned on facebook for some artists impressions, which we will release when they become available.

We have started some preliminary earthworks on the new recreation park across from McDonald's, however we are still working through our final approval. Once we have this we will release some artist impressions and information on what it will include. We want to ensure that we have full council support before we release this info, so please bear with us. Due to the high levels of homes being constructed in Gainsborough at the moment we have also seen a high increase in the amount of resident feedback about construction and tradie vehicles speeding through our streets. This is something that we do take very seriously and have been in touch with council to ensure they are also aware of the issues. We would encourage you to contact the police or council straight away to report this as they have the power to implement and enforce speed changes.

Construction on the sports fields and new recreation park at the western end of Gainsborough Greens are well underway and are looking to be opened in the coming months. We anticipate celebrating this in a big way, so stay tuned on Facebook for the announcement of the official opening event.

You may have also heard some recent media around the rail bridge from the Hotham Release over to the Old Pacific Highway, Mirvac are currently working with council to resolve this A<u>SAP</u>.
