It's all about new amenity for Gainsborough Greens residents this year. In addition to the new retail amenities popping up around our suburb we are also looking to complete and start construction on some pretty substantial recreational parks within Gainsborough.

Mirvac's vision for Gainsborough Greens has always been about connecting people to their community, whether by way of a community program, the vast amounts of open space, extensive walkways or our recreation parks. We are extremely proud of this all coming to fruition and the community really embracing all of these elements.

The new sport fields and adjacent recreation park is well underway, if you have been for a drive down that way recently you will have noticed some playground equipment installed.
