- Keeping any service boxes neat and tidy

Since 1993, Pimpama locals have been indulging in their very own slice of foodie heaven and the region's best kept secret, the Whistlestop Restaurant and meeting place.

Husband and wife duo Sarah and Rob Houston have evolved the family business inline with the community's needs since its humble beginnings as a general store.

The couple have seen the transformation of Whistlestop into a multi-faceted site including a cafe, restaurant, general store, bottle shop, corporate meeting space and function facility.

Sarah says the emergence of the Gainsborough Greens community has been a driving force in the continued success of their business.

"Our family enjoys the community aspect of our village, while the Gainsborough Greens community with its friendly residents runs parallel with our vision. It makes coming into work each day enjoyable," she said.

"We host weekly coffee meetings for the Gainsborough Greens social club and the whole group is a joy to have in the cafe. It's great to see that there are still communities where people take the time to get to know their neighbours.



"This group seems just like a bunch of old friends, even though there are people of all different ages and backgrounds, everyone gets along."

## Update from Coomera State MP Michael Crandon

Finally!  
Some good news for our Prawn Farmers to smile about.

It's been an emotional roller coaster for more than 5 months for people who have put half a lifetime into this industry, with White Spot Disease (WSD), devastated all our prawn farms on the Logan River.

After so much uncertainty, lobbying efforts have paid off...

Deputy Prime Minister, Barnaby Joyce and the Federal Government have responded to the prawn farmers cries for help with a \$20 million assistance package.

This is to partly compensate for losses and to provide some certainty for their future. The package will reimburse farmers affected by WSD, including 18 month shut down as part of agreed eradication plan.

The annual Cancer Council Biggest Morning Tea at the Jacobs Well Community Centre was a huge success this year.

The team from the Canefields Garden Group supplied delicious cakes and sandwiches accompanied by tea coffee and a laugh. Congratulations on raising over \$4000 for the Cancer Council. Judi from my office and I were fortunate enough to win a few raffle prizes from the huge number of prizes donated for the day. Almost all of our wins went towards the Domestic Violence donations drive to provide emergency packs for women and children fleeing domestic violence.

## Nature Walk & Talk

Commencing with a 'Welcome to Country' led by Yugambah Elder Shaun Davies, we learnt that the Indigenous tribes were larger in numbers along the coastal areas, like nearby Jacobs Well as there was a greater source of food. Paula also from the Yugambah people, shared her vast knowledge about

bush tucker, where we learnt that the native lemon myrtle tree is not only a great ingredient to be added to our cooking, that it is the second most exported plant out of Australia.

Our informative nature walk and talk was led by John White from Evolve Environmental Solutions residents learnt about the repurposed site timber that forms part of our connection paths and parks at Gainsborough Greens. Along with the plantings and intensive care and revegetation that has taken place. Being greeted by lots of wildlife, as we headed off the path, we were led towards the new sporting fields and park areas that will be a great place for the community to enjoy in the near future.

Finishing up with a lovely morning tea at the Swan Rd Park area, it was a gorgeous morning to be out exploring the beautiful nature on our doorstep at Gainsborough Greens.

# MIRVAC DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

We are excited to announce that we recently received council approval to start construction on a new park and playground area on the western side of Gainsborough Greens. You'll soon see development underway on the park, giving residents another great outdoor venue to enjoy.

The park will include a playground, half court, BBQ's & shelter, toilets as well as a fenced dog park. This park is likely to take six months to construct, as always we remind people, for their own safety, that this will be a construction site and access is strictly prohibited until such time as the construction fencing is removed.

Keep an eye out on our Facebook page for sneak peek construction pics.

It has been great to hear the growing support for a parkrun to be formed at Gainsborough, we are hopeful that with our anticipated approval and construction of the sports fields that we will be able to produce a more formal course that meets all of the park run requirements. Stay tuned for an update on our developing walkways.

In other news, the construction of our two current releases is anticipated to be complete by August with lots looking to receive title registration in approximately October.

You can expect to see an increase to building activity in and around Gainsborough with a record number of covenant applications coming through at the moment. We encourage you to look out for your future neighbours and make them feel welcome.
