Home Security Awareness

House break and enters are one of the most common crimes. In many instances house break-ins are crimes of opportunity with entry gained through an open or unlocked door or window. Good home security is as simple as the following three basic steps:

1. Make it as difficult as possible for an offender to gain entry i.e. install and use key operated locks
2. Make it as difficult as possible for an offender to exit with your property, i.e. use the key-operated locks on doors and windows, make sure alarms are functioning.
3. Make it as difficult as possible for an offender to want to steal your property i.e. engrave or microdot all items of value, keep valuables out of sight.

Annette said that although it had been a difficult year, the move to Gainsborough Greens had been a positive one and the neighbours very supportive.

"It began when Geoff moved a trailer load of large potted plants from Brisbane and several neighbours brought trolleys over to help him. People are very kind and friendly," she said.

"From that day onwards, the community spirit has just continued to grow and our neighbours have been fantastic.

"In fact, we are heading off on a cruise to New Zealand in November with Bronny and David from next door.

"We have met more people in the past 12 months living at Gainsborough Greens than we had in 18 years living in Brisbane and with initiatives such as golf days, craft groups and weekly morning teas, it's easy to see why."

Annette said the couple believed finding their new home in Gainsborough Greens was 'meant to be'.

"The way we found our home is quite interesting, as we visited Gainsborough Greens for the auction of a different house, however we were quite early so in the meantime decided to look at what is now our home," she said.

"The minute we saw the house backed onto the golf course, we knew it was perfect for us. It was quite spur of the moment, but I believe it was meant to be."

Annette said the combination of golf front living, 24 hour security and lifestyle amenities – including a pool, a gym and tennis court – she felt as if she was on holidays every day.

"It's very calming to sit out the back, watch the kangaroos and listen to the birds. There are lorikeets everywhere at the moment and they are just gorgeous," she said.

"Geoff is now semi-retired and drives the school bus for Surfside Buses, and he will often come home during the day to have a round of golf with one of our neighbours.

"Sometimes when he walks the dog, I think he must be lost because he runs into so many people that he's gone for hours. It's lovely to be part of this community."

Update from Coomera State MP Michael Crandon

Finally! Some good news for our Prawn Farmers to smile about.

It's been an emotional roller coaster for more than 5 months for people who have put half a lifetime into this industry, with White Spot Disease (WSD), devastated all our prawn farms on the Logan River.

After so much uncertainty, lobbying efforts have paid off...

Deputy Prime Minister, Barnaby Joyce and the Federal Government have responded to the prawn farmers cries for help with a \$20 million assistance package. This is to partly compensate for losses and to provide some certainty for their future. The package will reimburse farmers affected by WSD, including 18 month shut down as part of agreed eradication plan.

The annual Cancer Council Biggest Morning Tea at the Jacobs Well Community Centre was a huge success this year.

The team from the Canefields Garden Group supplied delicious cakes and sandwiches accompanied by tea coffee and a laugh. Congratulations on raising over \$4000.00 for the Cancer Council. Judi from my office and I were fortunate enough to win a few raffle prizes from the huge number of prizes donated for the day. Almost all of our wins went towards the Domestic Violence donations drive to provide emergency packs for women and children fleeing domestic violence.

MIRVAC DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Mirvac completed its 1000th sale at Gainsborough Greens, which is a big milestone for the community. The Gainsborough Greens community is something that Mirvac are extremely proud of, and as a result we have entered the estate into a number of categories in the UDIA awards. Judging takes place later this year and we will keep you all posted of the result.

With such a fast-growing community, we are about to add some new amenity and with construction about to start on the new park and playground area on Wraight Street on the western side of the estate. We are aiming for this to be finished and ready for use by the time the first resident is ready to move into their new home in

our latest stage in Green Park sometime in mid-2018. The Sports fields adjacent to this recreation park are likely to start around the same time in October this year with a similar completion date.

In other news, we are working on the design of our next body corporate rec centre which will be located on Gainsborough Drive west of Terrace Green, we hope to share these designs with the community in the coming months.
