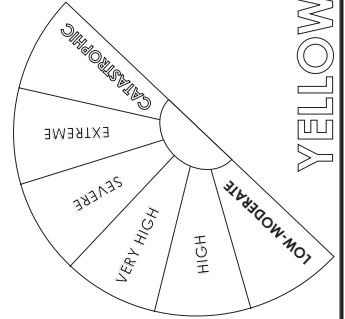
Q: Why is living on a hill a greater risk if there is a bush fire?

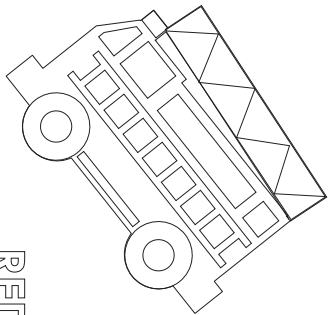
Q: What can travel kilometres from a bush fire and is responsible for the loss of 90% of homes?

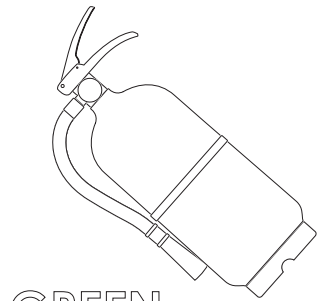
Q: What are the 3 things that keep a fire burning?
